Comments

1. The band does not require an external monitor system:
They bring their own monitor desk, mixer and in-ear system.

2. The band plays with an e-drum kit in the look of an ordinary Drumkit.
All cymbals are also electronic - so no microphones are necessary!

3. The band uses guitars and bass preamps with cab outputs
via D.I. No amps or cabinets, no microphones are necessary!

4. The band brings everything:

In addition to their monitor system and preamps,
they also bring their own microphones and stands.

(Singer Tom favors and bring his Neumann KMS 105, optionally
Shure KSM8, Beta 58 and Beta 57),
as well as all the necessary cables and cat-connections
to their own monitor desk.

5. Multiple Power-sockets at the front of the stage are required.
English power adapters will be provided by us.

6. There should be a little space behind the electric drum kit
for 3 roll-ups, which can be extended and retracted
in a few seconds.

7. If a projector is available that we are allowed to use,
an HDMI cable would be required
in the immediate vicinity of the drum kit.

8. The band brings a set of LED tubes with them, battery-powered
and are controlled automatically by our system via WDMX.
